may sit and eat in your kingdom.**

### **The Creed**

**We believe in one God,

Therefore, Lord and heavenly Father,  
in remembrance of the precious death and passion,

Jesus Christ, we offer you through him this our sacrifice of praise  
and thanksgiving. Grant that by his merits and death, and  
through faith in his blood, we and all your Church may receive  
forgiveness of our sins and all other benefits of his passion.  
Although we are unworthy, through our manifold sins, to offer  
you any sacrifice, yet we pray that you will accept this the duty  
and service that we owe.

Do not weigh our merits, but pardon our offences, and fill us all  
who share in this holy communion with your grace and heavenly  
blessing; through Jesus Christ our Lord, by whom, and with  
whom, and in whom, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all honour  
and glory be yours, almighty Father, for ever and ever.

### ***The Lord's Prayer***

As our Saviour taught us, so we pray

**Our Father in heaven,  
hallowed be your name,

Hear us, merciful Father, we humbly pray, and grant that, by the power of your Holy Spirit, we receiving these gifts of your creation, this bread and this wine, according to your Son our Saviour Jesus Christ's holy institution, in remembrance of his death and passion, may be partakers of his most blessed body and blood;

who, in the same night that he was betrayed, took bread and gave you thanks; he broke it and gave it to his disciples, saying: Take, eat; this is my body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of me.

In the same way, after supper he took the cup and gave you thanks; he gave it to them, saying: Drink this, all of you; this is my blood of the new covenant, which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me.

Praise to you, Lord Jesus:

**Dying you destroyed our death, rising you restored our life:  
Lord Jesus, come in glory.**

**We believe in the Holy Spirit,  
the Lord, the giver of life,  
who proceeds from the Father and the Son,  
who with the Father and the Son is worshipped and glorified,  
who has spoken through the prophets.  
We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church.  
We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins.  
We look for the resurrection of the dead,  
and the life of the world to come.  
Amen.**
