Verses 7 and 11 unison

1 God is our ' refuge and ' strength, ♦
a very ' present ' help in ' trouble;

2 Therefore we will not fear, though the ' earth be ' moved, ♦
and though the mountains tremble ' in the ' heart of the ' sea;

‡ 3 Though the waters ' rage and ' swell, ♦
and though the mountains ' quake • at the ' towering ' seas.

4 There is a river whose streams make glad the ' city of ' God, ♦
the holy place of the ' dwelling • of the ' Most ' High.

5 God is in the midst of her;
therefore shall she ' not be re'moved; ♦
God shall ' help her • at the ' break of ' day.

6 The nations are in uproar and the ' kingdoms are ' shaken, ♦
but God utters his voice and the ' earth shall ' melt a'way.

7 The Lord of ' hosts is ' with us; ♦
the God of ' Jacob ' is our ' stronghold.

8 Come and behold the ' works of the ' Lord, ♦
what destruction he has ' wrought up'on the ' earth.

9 He makes wars to cease in ' all the ' world; ♦
he shatters the bow and snaps the spear
and burns the ' chariots ' in the ' fire.

10 'Be still, and know that ' I am ' God; ♦
I will be exalted among the nations;
I will be ex'alted ' in the ' earth.'

11 The Lord of ' hosts is ' with us; ♦
the God of ' Jacob ' is our ' stronghold.
