## BABY & TODDLER GROUPS

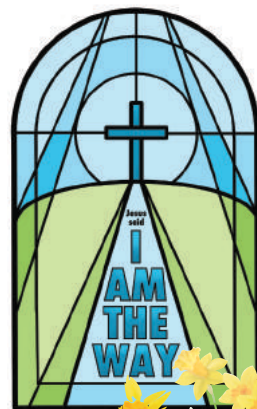
### St Michael's
