

CHRIS EVANS

It is with great sadness we announce that Chris Evans passed away peacefully at home on January 7th 2026.

Born Islwyn Evans in a small Welsh mining town in 1946, Chris, as we knew him, moved to London and qualified as a dentist from Kings College Hospital in 1970. Throughout his dental career, he always had a heart and a passion for mission. Newly married, he spent two years with Angela on St Helena, and at various times in Nigeria with SIM, with “Mercy Ships” in Liberia, with “Amazon Hope” on a hospital ship on the Amazon River, and finally with YWAM in Fiji. His focus was always to bring much needed dental care and Christian witness to all the local communities to which he was attached.

Arriving in Oxford with his family in 1985, Chris became heavily involved in many aspects of Cumnor life. He was our churchwarden and chaired the Fabric Committee for over 15 years. He served as Chair of the school governors, was Treasurer of Cumnor Parish News, and was a long-time member of North Oxford Rotary Club serving as President in 2004.

Everyone knew Chris as a lovely man, warm and sincere, a good friend, honest in all his relationships. He loved life and lived it well. He loved his family, and he loved his Lord. He will be hugely missed.
